### **Overview:**

This module supports survivor-authored complaints to: - The United Nations - Public Interest Disclosure (PID) bodies - Commissions or shadow report platforms

All templates are symbolic in nature and protected by the McLoughlin Charter.

# **COMPONENT 1: UN Complaint Template Shell**

**Includes:** - Framed denial or structural harm - Glossary-aligned impact narrative - Optional pseudonym logic (symbolic tag) - Reference to relevant convention (e.g., CRPD)

**Format:** .docx, .pdf, and webform-ready (coming soon)

### COMPONENT 2: PID Draft Scaffold

**Use when:** internal misconduct, concealment, or risk to community is involved.

**Structure:** - Type of wrongdoing (e.g., maladministration, negligence) - Evidence summary (symbolic ok) - Reprisal protection tag (optional pseudonym) - Designated recipient (oversight body or minister)

Output: Shell generates either a printable letter or civic petition

## **COMPONENT 3: Shadow Report Tile Builder**

Purpose: submit your experience as one 'tile' in a collective symbolic report.

 $\textbf{Template Includes:} \ \ \text{- What happened (50-250 words)} \ \ \text{- What changed or didn't - Optional system suggestion or glossary keyword}$ 

**Aggregation Format:** Exported in UN-compatible format (.docx/.json hybrid)
